



C-IED HUMINT ANALYST

Duties: Functions as a part of an Afghanistan based 5-10 person intelligence analytical team of military and/or DoD civilian analysts in support of USFOR-A, CJTF Paladin, Regional Command, BCT/RCT/MEU/MEB/Coalition BDE, and Battalion CJ2 staffs' analytical requirements. Responsible for researching, developing, presenting and the dissemination of HUMINT products at the tactical and operational level. Conducts analysis of raw and fused human intelligence and counterintelligence data of insurgents who are directly linked to the acquisition, production, transportation, emplacement and employment of IEDs.

Responsible for HUMINT analysis related to IED threats, Counter-IED mission planning, target development, damage assessment and counter-terrorism in the AOR general area. Provide the Commander with critical intelligence on the cultural environment, tribal leadership, economic concerns, political issues, and local governance which are necessary to carry out both non-kinetic and kinetic operations. This intelligence will be derived not only from classified databases, but also OSINT, NGO reports and presentations, PSYOPS, and other sources focused beyond direct kinetic operations or responses to enemy actions. Establish close working relationships with HUMINT collectors in Afghanistan to include the Defense HUMINT operators and Defense HUMINT Operations Chief (HOC), Joint Counterintelligence Unit – Afghanistan (JCIU-A) personnel, and other IC HUMINT Collectors, in order to obtain the most complete picture of the environment. Coordinate with respective CMs to develop time-sensitive collection requirements and other HUMINT resources in support of C-IED, CJOA-A, or national HUMINT collections requirements. Produce products including C-IED mission analysis and planning briefings and annexes, CT assessments, target development packages, IED threat network nodal analysis, damage assessments, and all-source exploitation of documents and media from C-IED operations and detainees.

Selection and Employment Criteria:

- Possess a TS/SCI clearance
- Minimum of 4 years analytical experience within DoD or equivalent Government agency (HUMINT experience in either IED/C-IED, CT, South West Asia regional issues and HUMINT, CI or military analysis desired).
- Strong research and writing skills and be capable of effectively operating as a member of a strategic level analytical team in the accomplishment of assessments of sources and their reporting through the corroboration of source reporting, analytic feedback, quality assurance and the development of HUMINT and intelligence products and assessments.
- Have experience or a working knowledge of geo-referencing tools such as, CIDNE, M3, WISE, TAC, Harmony, ANB, Axis Pro, Palantir, ArcGis, Google Earth, CELLEX, IC Reach.
- Possess a working knowledge of Afghanistan, SW Asia regional issues, POL/MIL, tribal/cultural analysis, IED/C-IED OPS, Tactical, operational, theater, national, DoD, and service collection platform capabilities, collection management planning, synchronization, execution and assessment. Communications and dissemination architectures. Falconview and C2PC.
