Conduct in-depth research, gather information, identify intelligence gaps, interpret and evaluate information from multiple and sometimes contradictory sources, and make recommendations. Monitor trends and events related to a particular country or issue and author and deliver written and oral assessments. Collect, manipulate, and analyze intelligence data and advise government client based on findings. Mentor junior and mid-level staff on current intelligence capabilities and work to craft and develop new techniques. Leverage subject matter expertise to advise government clients. Advise customers and teammates on a particular country, geographic region, or issue and lead or delegate tasks as needed.
